**Faith at Home: Exodus 20 1-17**

**The Ten Commandments**

**Let's pray together:**



Lord Jesus, we come together as your family, so that we can grow together in you.

We come together to say thank you.

We come together to ask for God's help.

We come together to hear God's story.

We come together to celebrate God's love.

God is here, God is with us.

Amen.

**Let's create...a lollipop stick scroll**

**You will need:**

- **10 Lollipop Sticks**
- **Masking tape of sticky tape**
- **Pens/pencils**
- **Ribbon**
- **2 pairs of hands!**

**What to do:**

Lay the 10 sticks down, one under the other, leaving a small gap between each one.

Cut sticky tape to fit down the side of the sticks.

Carefully (you might need another pair of hands!) stick the tape down each side.

Turn the sticks over and stick tape down on the other side.

Write the commandments on each stick

1. Put God first
2. Worship only Him
3. No bad words

4. Work 6 rest 1
5. Respect your parents and those who care for you
6. Harm no one
7. Do not cheat
8. If it is not yours, do not take it
9. Tell the truth
10. Do not be jealous of other people's 'stuff'



**God gives us commandments/rules about how to worship Him and how to live peacefully with each other.**

If you do not have lollipop sticks that's ok...

**You will need:**

- Paper
- Pens/Pencils

Draw around your hands and write a commandment on each finger.



**Let's talk...about rules!**

- Why do we have rules?
- How do they help us?
- Maybe the family can get together and make some house rules?
- Decide your rules together and write them on card or paper and put them up somewhere you can see them to remind you.

## **Creative Prayer Activity...**

**Think about the Ten Commandments that God gave Moses**

**Then think about what Jesus said...**

**The second is this, Love your neighbour as yourself (love each other)  
There is no other commandment greater than these.**
