**Let's create...**

**You will need:**

- Paper
- Pens/pencils
- Sticky plaster/bandage
- Draw around your hands.
- Make your fingers and thumbs into the Ten Lepers.
- Choose one to say thank you.
- Write on sticky plaster/bandage 'Jesus Heals.'



**When one of them saw that he was healed he came back. He praised God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him.**

## Let's make...a placemat!

### You will need:

- A piece of A4 or A3 paper
- Felt tip pens/pencils
- Plate to draw round.
- Write along the top of the paper, Thank you for.....
- Draw a circle in the middle (where your plate will go).
- Decorate around the edges with your favourite foods.

Quite often you will see a scarecrow in the field to stop the birds eating the seeds.

## Let's make...a scarecrow

### You will need:

- Cardboard roll
- Paper cake case
- Spaghetti/straw/wool
- Pens/pencils
- Glue or sticky tape
- Lollipop stick

### What to do:

- Glue or sticky tape spaghetti/straw/wool around the top of the paper cake case to look like hair. Put the paper cake case over the top of the roll (as shown in the photo).
- Draw a face on the cardboard roll.
- Draw buttons and patches on the roll.
- Glue or sticky tape lollipop stick on the back of the roll to look like arms.



### Silly Mr. Scarecrow

Standing all alone

(stand straight, arms at sides)

Will you make the crows

(wave arms to scare off crows)

Leave the corn alone?

### Scary Mr. Scarecrow

Fierce as you can be.

(make scary faces)

You might scare away the crows

## **Creative Prayer Activity... Musical 'thank you' chairs.**

### **You will need.**

- **Chairs or cushions**
  - **Music**
  - **Coloured paper/card**
  - **An Adult**
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- Place the chairs/cushions in a circle (same amount as people playing)
  - Place a different colour piece of paper/card on SOME of the chairs/cushions
  - Play music and walk around chairs/cushions.
  - When music stops sit on a seat.
  - Whoever sits on seat with coloured paper must think of something they are thankful for that is that colour.
  - For example: if you sit on a green piece of paper, you could say thank you for, trees, grass or sprouts!!!
